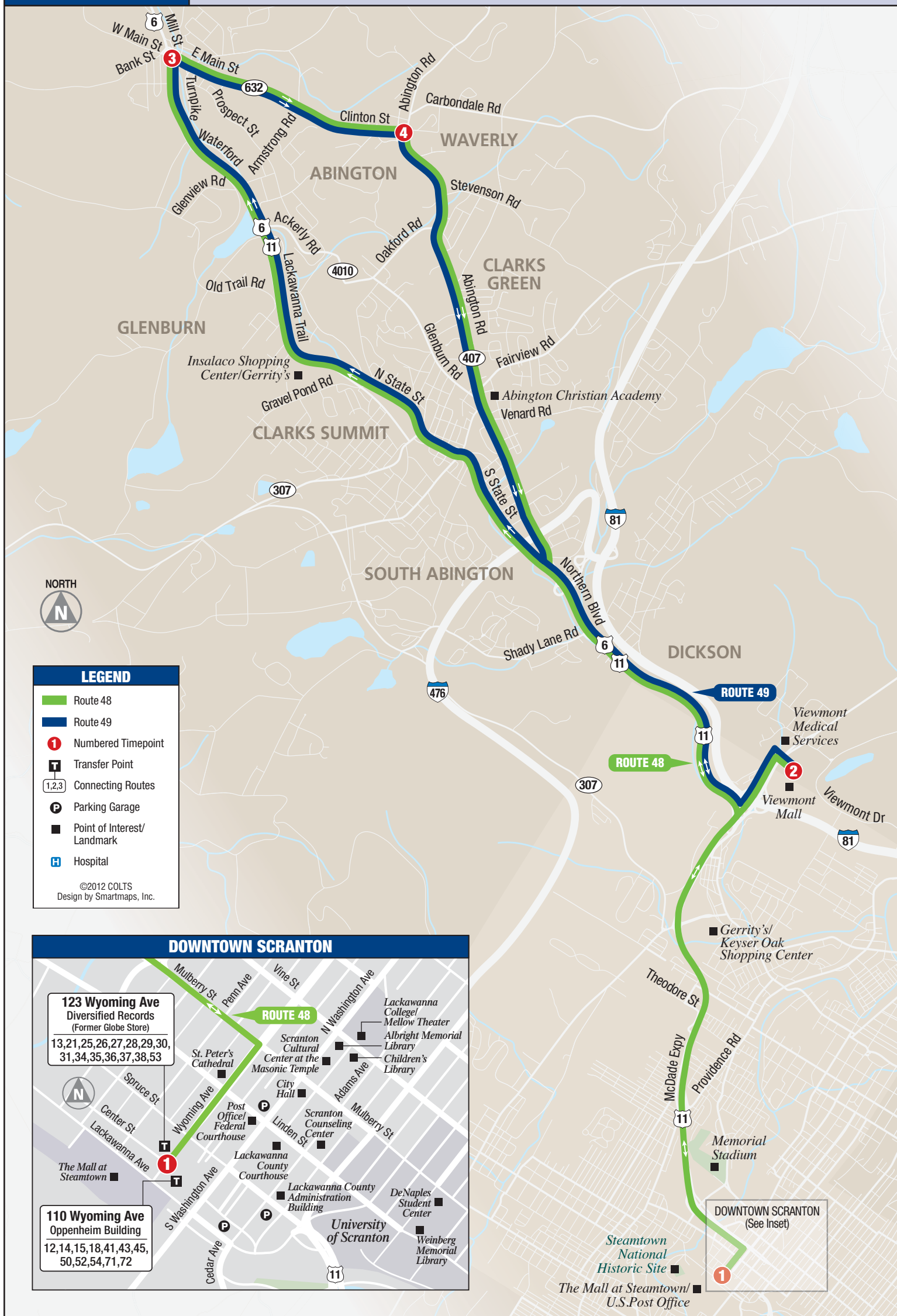

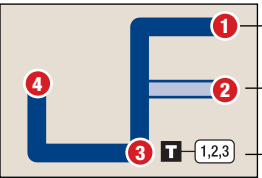

- 1** The bus stops at this location at listed times. Look for the column of times below the matching symbol in the schedule.
 - Only certain trips operate along this portion of the route. See the schedule for trips that provide service here.
 - 1,2,3** Transfer point. Shows where bus intersects with other routes available for transfer.
- The bus stops at the times listed below the numbered symbol. Light times are A.M.; bold times are P.M.
- The timetable shows when the bus is scheduled to depart. Actual times may vary and depend upon traffic and weather conditions. Arrive at the bus stop 2-3 minutes early to avoid missing the bus.

Transfers

Transfers are available for 50 cents and can be used when you are traveling more than one bus route. Ask your driver for one as soon as you board the bus. Transfers can only be purchased at the same time as your regular cash fare. Half-fare transfers are 25 cents. Transfers are for use only in continuous direction – from point of origin to point of destination. Transfers are not good for a return trip on the same route, or on any other route returning to your point of origin. Transfers are good only for 90 minutes from the time of purchase and only on the date purchased.

How to Pay

Please have your fare or pass ready before you board. If you do not have exact change, you will be issued a change card, as drivers do not carry any cash.

Connecting service to other counties

Connecting service to Luzerne County Transportation Authority is available on the Piston route at Main Avenue & Broad Street, on the Old Forge route at Main Street and Orchard Street, and at Mohegan Sun.

Lost & Found

If you leave something on a COLTS bus, you can call 346-2061 to see if it was found. Items left at COLTS administrative offices for more than 30 days will be donated to charity.

Title VI Rights

Pursuant to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, COLTS must ensure that “federally supported transit services and related benefits are distributed in an equitable manner.” COLTS operates all of its programs and activities without regard for race, color, or national origin. As such, COLTS is committed to a non-discrimination policy in all of its business and activities. If a complainant is not satisfied with the results of COLTS’ findings, he/she may appeal to: Federal Transit Administration –Region 3, Office of Civil Rights, 1760 Market St., Suite 510, Philadelphia, PA 19103-4124.

Transit Watch

Hours of Service

Weekdays: 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
Saturdays: 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
COLTS does not have service on Sundays.
COLTS does not provide bus service on the following holidays: New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day.
All COLTS buses are ADA compliant.
ADA wheelchair limitations: 30” x 48” chair size. There is a 600 lb. combined weight limit.
Some earlier and later service is available on select COLTS routes on both weekdays and Saturdays. Please see individual schedules for timetables.

Regular Fares

- Seniors 65 and older ride FREE all the time with a Senior Fare card. These are available through COLTS.
- Cash: \$1.50
- Children 45 inches and shorter and accompanied by an adult ride free.
- College students, faculty and staff may be able to ride certain routes for free. Please check with your college or visit www.coltsbus.com/colleges for more information.

COLTS Passes

- 31-day passes: \$48; 10-ride passes: \$13.50
- Students with valid student ID: 31-day passes: \$24; 10-ride student passes: \$6.75
- Day pass: \$3.50

Reduced Fares

- If you have a valid Medicare card, you can ride at the reduced rate of half the regular fare. Applications for Reduced Fare Cards are available at www.coltsbus.com under “COLTS Fares.”
- People who are employed and meet federal low-to-moderate income guidelines may be eligible for a discounted bus pass. Call 346-2061, ext. 1264 for more information.
